
## **Rickett's Hornpipe**

<sup>\*</sup>To play it as a hornpipe, each pair of eighth notes is played approximately as a dotted eighth and a sixteenth, and speed should be around 120 quarter-note beats per minute.

To play the tune as a reel, play much faster (such as 90 half-notes per minute) and lose most of the lilt (you will, anyway). rev. 11/18/06
